**OFFICIAL BALLOT GENERAL ELECTION
MARION COUNTY, INDIANA - NOVEMBER 8, 2016**

CASTING A VOTE: To vote for the candidate of your choice, darken the oval to the LEFT of the candidate's name. If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the Election Official and obtain another. Do not attempt to erase any marks made in error.

PUBLIC QUESTIONS: To vote on a public question, darken the oval to the left of the word 'YES' or 'NO' following each question.

WRITE-IN: To vote for a write-in candidate, write the name of the candidate on the line provided and darken the oval. A write-in vote will NOT be counted unless the vote is for a DECLARED write-in candidate.

STRAIGHT PARTY VOTING: To vote a Straight Party Ticket for all Democrat, Republican, or Libertarian candidates on this ballot, darken the oval to the left of the party name and do not make any other marks on this ballot. If you wish to vote for a candidate seeking a nonpartisan office or on a public question, you must darken the oval in the appropriate place on this ballot.

SPLIT-TICKET VOTING: You may vote a Straight Party Ticket by darkening the oval to the left of ONE party choice and then by darkening the oval for individual candidates of your choice in any other party OR you may darken the oval to the left of your candidate choice in each office.

PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS: A ballot cast for the named candidates for President and Vice President of the United States is considered a ballot cast for the slate of presidential electors nominated by that political party or independent candidate.

JUDICIAL RETENTION QUESTIONS: If you wish to vote on a judicial retention question, you must darken the oval to the left of the word 'YES' or 'NO' following each question.
